OFFICIAL SHOW RULES

1. This is a two-day cooped show.
2. All animals in the showroom must be entered in show or in a rented coop.
3. This is an ARBA, ASRBA, and Sycamore Satin sanctioned show and will be governed by the latest revision of the Official Show Rules by the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. Your entry indicates your acceptance of these rules.
4. Ear numbers are required on entry forms. Ear Tattoo Substitution will be accepted for the same breed, variety, sex and class for a \$2.00 per ear tattoo substitution fee.
5. All exhibitors must check in with show secretary by 9:00 pm EST on Friday, April 27, 2018.
6. All rabbits must be in cages, with available feed and water, by the close of showroom at 11:00 pm EST on Friday, April 27, 2018.
7. Wood shavings will be provided as bedding.
8. The show committee reserves the right to make any changes necessary, including substitution, addition or deletion of any judges.
9. Exhibitor must provide feed and water containers for each animal entered and are responsible for feeding and watering their animals.
10. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed in the left ear prior to showing. All animals must also have the coop number in the right ear. Exhibitors are responsible for placing coop number in right ear.
11. All rabbits are entered at owner's risk. Every precaution will be taken to minimize hazards, losses or mistakes. ASRBA, Sycamore Satins Association of Indiana, Show committee personnel, Boone County 4-H, Inc, Boone County Fairgrounds are in no way responsible for losses due to theft, death, fire, accident, destruction, injury to any animal, etc. All entries are made at owners / exhibitors own risk.

OFFICIAL SHOW RULES

12. Animals must be healthy and care of the animal is the responsibility of owner. Any rabbit showing signs of sickness, disease or being unhealthy will be excused or removed from showroom and entry fee for such animal is forfeited. Show Superintendent provides such removal.
13. All fees owed must be paid with entry submission.
14. Rabbits that are locked in or not in their assigned coops at time of judging will be scratched from their class. Entry fee of such animal is forfeited.
15. Only authorized persons will be allowed behind judges tables.
16. Children must be under the supervision of an adult at all times. Parents/guardians are responsible for children's actions and any damages they may cause.
17. Roller skates, scooters, skateboards, roller blades, balls or running will not be allowed in buildings.
18. Smoking not allowed in buildings or within 10 feet of entry doors.
19. No animals other than rabbits and dogs with certification will be allowed in the showroom. Certification must be provided prior to entrance.
20. Complaints will be addressed with the Show Superintendent .
21. Sycamore Satins Association of Indiana reserves the right to refuse any entries for whatever reasons it feels necessary for the safety and general welfare of the show.
22. Rabbits will be released upon completion of the auction on Sunday. No rabbits will be allowed to leave showroom prior to release.
23. Rabbits remaining in showroom after 2:00 pm Sunday will become property of the Sycamore Satins Association of Indiana.
24. The show superintendent shall make decisions which are not specifically covered by show rules. All decisions are final.
25. No shipped in rabbits will be accepted.
